

# Enroflox<sup>®</sup> (enrofloxacin) Injection For Dogs 2.27%

20 mL, 50 mL & 100 mL: LABEL CHANGE



## What are the label changes?

The new label for Enroflox<sup>®</sup> Injection 2.27% has a **90 day broaching statement**. Previously there was no broaching statement on this product. This applies to the 20ml, 50ml and 100ml sizes. See actual label excerpt below:

**STORAGE:** Store at 59°-77°F (15°-25°C). Excursions permitted up to 86°F (30°C). Brief exposure to temperature up to 104°F (40°C) may be tolerated provided the mean kinetic temperature does not exceed 77°F (25°C); however, such exposure should be minimized. Protect from direct sunlight. Do not freeze. Use within 90 days of first puncture.

## When will you see the new labeled product?

We are working through inventories of the old label of all sizes in our Lenexa warehouse, and we will rotate the new 90 day label product in as the old runs out.

## What is a “broaching statement”?

A broaching statement defines the time at which a bottle is initially pierced until the time the product should no longer be used.

## Competitive Advantage:

Baytril<sup>®</sup> Injectable Solution 2.27% (Bayer) has a limit of 20 punctures, in addition to the 90 days:

dose range and treatment duration. Use within 90 days of first puncture and puncture a maximum of 20 times. Any product remaining after 20 punctures or more than 90 days after initial puncture should be discarded.

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
